WELCOME TO AUDITIONS FOR *IRVING BERLIN'S HOLIDAY INN!* Please review the information below and on the back of this letter. Any questions may be referred to our volunteers at the desk. We wish you the very best on your audition!

Audition Procedure and Policy

You must be entering Grade 4 in the 2025/2026 school year, or be turning 22 after August 16, 2025.

You must have prepared 16 to 32 bars of a classic standard song (no contemporary styles, please - meaning NO rock, pop, hip-hop, soul, or R&B; you MAY use a song from the show, another Irving Berlin song, or another song similar in style). You must also have sheet music for your song in the correct key. You will be brought in to sing for the directors individually.

You will also be taught a dance audition which you will perform (in groups) for the directors. You may wear (or change into) character shoes, jazz shoes, dance shoes, or sneakers if necessary. Please, NO sandals, flip-flops, Birkenstocks, open-toed shoes, Crocs, Heelys, Uggs, or bare/stocking feet.

You will be auditioning for Director/Producer Brian Bianco, Music Director Benjamin McCormack, Choreographer Alexandra Cahr, and Associate Producers Grady Dennis and Lauren Gulliver Travers. We will hear you sing one at a time, in the order you've signed in. After we've sung through the first ten to fifteen people, that group will start learning the dance audition as we sing through the next group of ten to fifteen people, and so on. We will take breaks from singing to watch each dance group perform for the directors. While we cannot say for sure how long you will be here, we'll work to get you out as soon as possible. All roles are open. Cast size will be no larger than 50, but several opportunities are also available on our crew and other areas of production. Please consult our volunteers or call 203-329-8207 (x 700) for more.

Callbacks will be May 20, 2025 starting at 5:00pm *if and as needed*. Anyone we may need to see again for a callback will receive a phone call. If you are not called back, it DOES NOT mean we are not considering you for casting. At the latest, our cast list will be posted online at www.curtaincallinc.com by the end of the day May 27, 2025.

The Commitment - There is a \$50 participation fee for all cast and crew (payable only if your child is cast or accepted onto the crew). Sibling discounts (of 50% after the 1st child) and scholarships are available. For more information call 203-329-8207 (x700).

Our production calendar is on the back of this letter. Please review it carefully and list ANY AND ALL potential conflicts on the back of your audition form. Even if you are not sure of details, please list <u>anything</u> you are aware of. If you do NOT have any conflicts, please write, "No conflicts." Curtain Call has a strict attendance policy. Any conflicts we are unaware of prior to the start of rehearsal can negatively affect the production schedule and even lead to dismissal. Anyone with more than one week's worth of conflicts or conflicts spanning July 21 through August 16 will not be considered for casting. (No exceptions.)

A special First Company and Parent Meeting and Company Bonding Day will take place on Saturday, June 7 from 11:00am to 2:00pm. From 11:00am to 11:45am will be an informative meeting with parents, cast, and crew to review the commitment and answer any questions. From 11:45am to 2:00pm will be company bonding (cast and crew) activities.

Rehearsals: Mondays through Thursdays 6:30pm to 9:30pm, beginning no earlier than June 9. Weekend rehearsals are reserved June 28, 29, July 12, 13, 19, 20 as needed between the hours of 1:00pm and 6:00pm. We would not use both a Saturday and Sunday in the same weekend, but one or the other (and not necessarily that whole duration of time). Rehearsal schedules will be distributed every two weeks. Not every cast member is required for every rehearsal. **No one will be excused July 21 thru August 16, 2025.**

Tech and Dress Rehearsals: Saturday, August 2 will be our Sitzprobe (tentatively 10:00am to 2:00pm). Our Tech Sunday is August 3: an all-day rehearsal with crew called at 1:00am, cast called at 1:00pm, and lasting until 11:00pm for all. Dinner for the entire company will be provided. Dress rehearsals are August 4, 5, 6, 7 from 6:00pm to 11:00pm. **All cast must attend these dates.** (**No exceptions.**)

Performances: August 8, 9, 14, 15, 16 at 7:30pm, and August 10 at 2:00pm. AUGUST 10 AND 13 AT 7:30PM ARE ON HOLD SHOULD WE NEED TO ADD PERFORMANCES. **All cast must attend all performances and be available for the on hold dates as well.**

Tear-Down/Strike: August 17 beginning 10:30am. Cast and crew must attend.

PRODUCTION DATES

JUNE 7, 11am-2pm: First Company and Parent Meeting, and Company Bonding. From 11am-11:45am will be a meeting with all cast, crew, and parents to discuss the summer commitment & answer questions. 11:45am-2pm will be spent in company-bonding activities. Our crew is welcome.

JUNE 9-JULY 31, Monday to Thursdays, 6:30-9:30pm: Regular rehearsals. Conflicts with these dates are *negotiable*. If you are missing more than a week's worth of conflicts in this time, however, please do NOT audition. Rehearsal schedules will be distributed every two weeks.

JULY 1: All bios are due for the playbill. (Email to brian@curtaincallinc.com.)

June 28, 29, JULY 12, 13, 19, 20: These weekend dates are ON HOLD for rehearsals between the hours of 1pm and 6pm as needed. We would not schedule a Saturday and Sunday back to back, one day or the other. More than likely, we will not use ALL dates. Advance notice will be given. Rehearsal schedules will be distributed every two weeks.

JULY 21-31, Monday to Thursday evenings: Final detailing and run thru rehearsals. Cast is off book (fully memorized). Our Running Crew will join us for rehearsals the week of July 28. FULL CAST REQUIRED: NO EXCEPTIONS.

AUGUST 2: Sitz probe - a full cast music rehearsal with the pit musicians (tentatively 10am-2pm) FULL CAST REQUIRED: NO EXCEPTIONS.

AUGUST 3: Tech Sunday, an all day process with crew called at 11am, cast called AT 1pm, and ending as late as 11pm. Dinner will be provided. FULL CAST ATTENDENCE REQUIRED: NO EXCEPTIONS.

AUGUST 4-7: Dress rehearsals. Estimated call time 6pm (subject to change): Can go as late as 11pm. FULL CAST REQUIRED: NO EXCEPTIONS.

PERFORMANCES: August 8, 9, 14, 15, 16 at 7:30pm and August 10 at 2pm. AUGUST 10 AND 13 AT 7:30PM ARE ON HOLD SHOULD WE NEED TO ADD PERFORMANCES. **FULL CAST REQUIRED:** *NO EXCEPTIONS.*

AUGUST 17: Tear-down and strike at 10:30am. FULL CAST AND PARENT HELP NEEDED.

*FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS AGE 18 AND UP: SAFE SPACE PROCEDURES

As part of our ongoing efforts at providing a safe, nurturing environment at Curtain Call, and to be in compliance with requirements of Stamford Public Schools, we have moved to an online source (Spot-Screening) to handle background checks for all Curtain Call participants age 18 and up. This applies to parent volunteers, performers, crew members, etc., as well as our regular staff, production team members, and teaching artists.

THERE HAVE BEEN NO INCIDENTS AT CURTAIN CALL. We are just being conscious of issues around us in the world. (Stamford Public Schools will no longer allow us to provide programming without Sexual Misconduct/Sexual Molestation insurance coverage and we can't get affordable coverage without conducting these background checks.)

Participants age 18 and up will be required to provide electronic consent for this background check. Consent will include authorizing Spot Screening to email a copy of the completed background check to Executive Director Lou Ursone. All information will be treated with strict confidentiality, in accordance with applicable privacy laws. The PDF reports that are issued to us for file purposes, will have the Social Security number redacted.

There is no cost to you for this. You may go online to do this now, or wait till you receive a callback or offer, (or offer to serve as an adult volunteer) but it must be completed within 24 hours of an offer or your offer will be rescinded.
